The winners are selected by an independent panel of international judges.

The awards are intended to publicly recognize police officers who by their efforts have contributed significantly to crime reduction; to the enhancement of community relations; to the improvement of general safety and security; and who have made an overall difference in their police forces, communities and by extension nationally and regionally. The police forces of the three first place winners will each receive cash prizes of US\$5,000.00 to apply to welfare projects as identified by the respective Police Commissioners and their teams.

Congratulations not only to our awardees but to all the officers who continue to keep the Caribbean region a safe environment.


